Select Slide Template

There are a number of slides that are pre-formatted for text and photos

Click on the Add Slide button

We will select the TITLE slide first

The text in the slide tells you what to do!

Add another Slide

Click on ADD A SLIDE

Select the slide with TITLE, BULLETS & PHOTO

- Then Double click in this section and Key the bullet points
- Click the camera in the image and select a photo file from your hard drive

Add Another Slide

Add additional slides, selecting from the template options of Title, text, images

Or

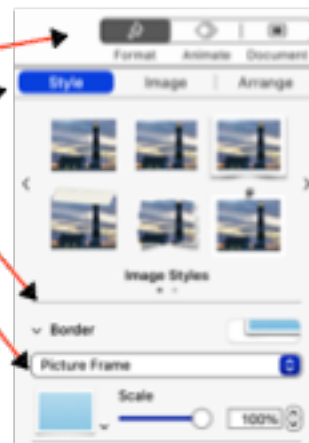
Create your own from a blank slide

Add a Frame to a Photo

- Select Photo
- Format
- Style
- Border
- Picture Frame

Resize a Photo

Photos can be resized using standard click and drag actions

- Click the photo
- Click and hold one of the white anchor squares
- Move in or out to the desired size

Move a Photo

Keynote elements can be moved from one location to another

- Use standard Click and Drag action
- Click on the photo
- Drag to a new location

Keynote elements can be moved from one location to another

Text Editing

- Click the Text Box
- Click on Format
- Click on Text
- Options
 - Font, Size, Color
 - Spacing
 - Bullets

Copy/Paste

Keynote elements can be copied and pasted from one slide to another using standard Copy/Paste commands

- Click on Text, Text Box, or Image
- Right Click
- Copy
- Select Destination
- Right Click
- Paste

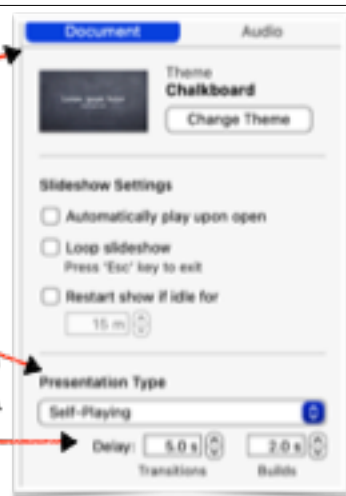
Presentation Type

Delay Settings

TRANSITIONS is the time between slides

BUILDS is the time between elements on a slide

- To see the slide show in action:
- Click on the starting slide
 - Then Click the PLAY button at the top of the screen
 - Press ESCAPE to stop the slide show

Animation can be added to display text and photos

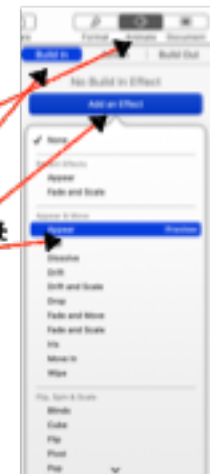
Some examples are shown on the following screens

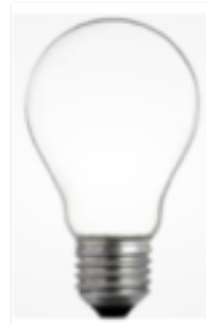

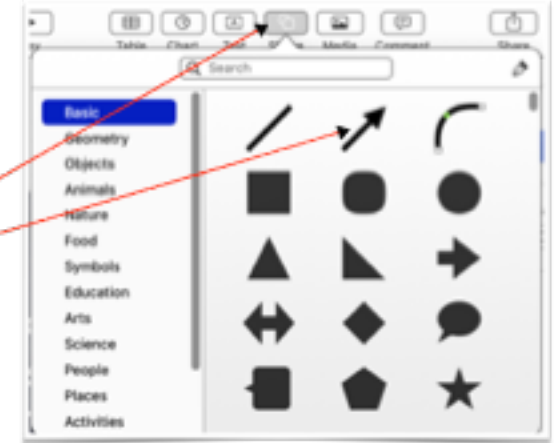

To add Arrows:

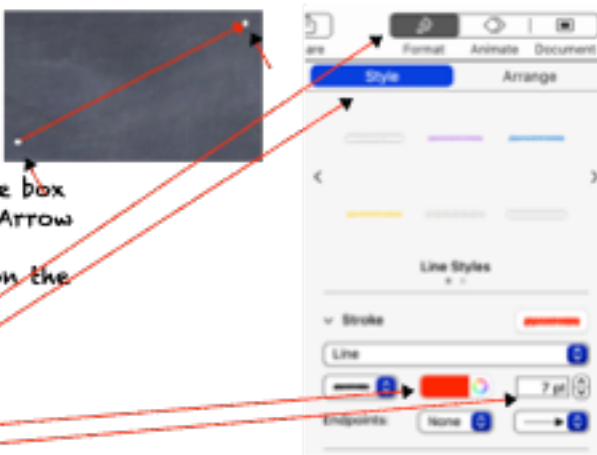
- Click on SHAPE
- Select Arrow

Format Arrows:

- Click on Arrow
- Click on the white box at the end of the Arrow
- Move each end to desired position on the screen
- Change the color
 - Format
 - Style
 - Color - Red
 - Line Thickness

Click on the Build Order Button to change the order the text and images are displayed

There are many options in the Build Order box

The Build Order box Lists all elements defined with an Animate option

Move them around to display in the order you want

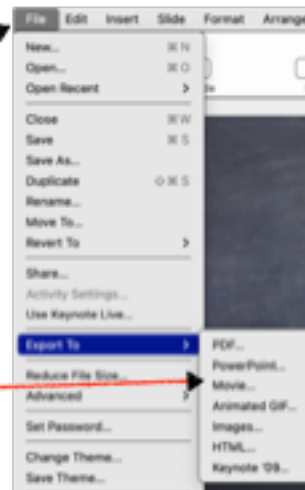

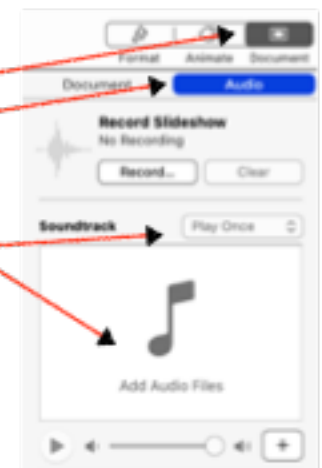
